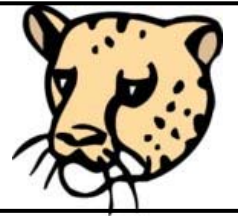

Liturgy Leaders and the Martha's

The Liturgy Leaders enjoyed their first service venture with the Martha's on Friday, October 15. Everyone did their part, and we were able to accomplish a lot of cleaning in a little time.



One of the reasons this service project is so successful is the awareness of personal responsibility it elicits from the volunteers. Here are a couple of reminders from the Liturgy Leaders on how you can help take care of God's house — the church.

— Don't play with the books in the pews. Pages are easily torn or wrinkled, which can ruin the books and prevent people from being able to read and sing along during the Mass.

— Don't eat or drink in the sanctuary. We're not allowed to have candy or gum during the school day, but this is important to remember even when you are going to Sunday Mass with your family. We found thirty-four pieces of gum under the pews that day. Eating and drinking in the sanctuary desecrates the space

where Jesus offers Himself to us during the Mass (and breaks the fast before communion).

— Remember to take with you any used tissues and papers, etc. We found a few stuck between the books.

Together, we can ensure that God's house stay clean and that all of the items used to help us worship as a community are available to use.

***The Lost Hero* by Rick Riordan.** Jason, Piper, and Leo, three students from a school for "bad kids," find themselves at Camp Half-Blood, where they learn that they are demigods and begin a quest to free Hera, who has been imprisoned by Mother Earth herself.

***Halt's Peril (Book 9 of the Ranger's Apprentice)* by John Flanagan.** Tennyson, the false prophet of the Outsider cult, has escaped and Halt is determined to stop him before he crosses the border into Araluen, but Genovesan assassins put Will and Halt's extraordinary archery skills to the test.
